

PRIVACY POLICY

At the **Interactive Games & Entertainment Association Ltd** (ABN: 40 101 586 958) (defined here as 'IGEA', 'We', 'Us' or 'Our'), We recognise the importance of your privacy and understand the concerns surrounding the security of your information.

Our Privacy Policy sets out how We collect, use and disclose "personal information" and other "non-personal information" We have gathered about you in relation to your interactions with Us either as a member of IGEA, or by contacting Us, or by using Our website which can be found [here](#). ("Website").

This policy will let you know:

- What information (often referred to as 'data') is collected from you;
- How your information is used;
- With whom your information may be shared; and
- How you can access, update, or delete your information.

We will comply with all relevant and applicable legislative requirements, and, in the event of any inconsistency, the legislative requirements will override the provisions of this document.

What data do we collect?

We collect data in two ways.

- A. Data you provide Us; and
- B. Data collected by Our partners.

Age Limits

We do not collect any personally identifiable information of anyone under the age of 13 years.

How do We use the data we collect?

Data collected can be personal to you or non-personal, and sometimes data that doesn't appear to be personal can become personal if certain other facts are learned. No matter how We come to collect your data, We will always treat it in accordance with this document, and any applicable legislation, including the *Privacy Act 1998* (Cth) and the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs).

What is Personal Information?

'Personal Information' is information that identifies you as an individual. This is only collected by Us if you submit it to Us directly. Please note that if you become a member of IGEA We will keep a copy of your payment details.

A. Data collected by our partners

We note that We use third-party services during our ordinary course of business. We do not control how these third-party services interact with you and you should ensure that you consent to the terms of use and privacy policies offered by the third-party services before providing them with your information.

Membership

We use Google Forms to obtain information from our members at the time of acquiring membership. A copy of the Google Privacy Policy can be found here:

When you opt in to join our mailing list, We will use the information you directly provide Us with to provide you with communications about upcoming events, industry updates and activities that IGEA has recently undertaken or plans to undertake.

You may unsubscribe from Our newsletter at any time. All you need to do is click unsubscribe from the link in the newsletter or let us know in writing that you want to be removed by sending us an email at: info@igea.net.

If you wish to receive information from IGEA, you will be asked to provide your email address to us.

This information (i.e., email address) is gathered by a third-party partner (i.e., MailChimp) that collects and compiles that information for Us so that We may undertake mail outs to large numbers of people. We also use the Microsoft Office suite of applications, including Office 365 and the 'Sway' service which allows Us to create and distribute newsletters to Our Members and contacts. What about Sensitive Information?

Sensitive information includes information about such things as an individual's racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, membership of a political association, religious or philosophical beliefs, membership of a professional body, criminal records or health information.

We will not attempt to obtain nor record any sensitive information.

Access to Your Data, and Permanent Deletion of Your Data

We will retain your data only as necessary for our legitimate business interests, such as to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements.

Regardless of how We come in contact with your data, you have the right to request access to any personal information We hold about you. You may request access to the information We hold about you by contacting Us via email at privacy@igea.net. If at any time you believe that personal information about you is incorrect, incomplete or inaccurate, you may request that We amend such information. If We refuse your request, We will provide you a written notice which will outline the reasons for such refusal and the complaint mechanisms available to you.

You may also request that We delete any personal information We hold about You by contacting Us via email at privacy@igea.net.

Data Subject Requests

In the event that you send a data subject request to Us, or one of Our third-party partners informs Us that you have contacted them directly about your personal data they collected while you were using Our service, We will respond to that request in accordance with the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth).

If you wish to know what data We hold about you, if any, please make out your request to Us in writing at the address listed below. Please be aware that in order to protect the information in Our database, We will require identification from you before releasing any information.

Disclosure and Security of Your Information

We will not sell, trade, rent or disclose any of the personal information you provide to us for any reason, without your prior consent. Otherwise, your Personal Information will only be disclosed where required or allowable by law.

Your Personal Information is stored offsite in a manner that reasonably protects it from misuse, loss, unauthorised access, modification or disclosure. Technical measures are in place to protect your personal data, and transfers of your information are limited to the necessary minimum.

International Transfers of Your Information

Given that IGEA's Website is globally accessible, there are times where your data may need to be transferred across different jurisdictions. However, we will not transfer your personal information across jurisdictions, unless:

- You have provided your consent; or
- It is necessary to complete a transaction in Our Website; and
- We believe that the recipient of such information is subject to a law, or a binding scheme, that has the effect of protecting your information in a way that, overall, is at least substantially similar to the way in which the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) protect information; and there are mechanisms you can access to take action to enforce that protection of the law or binding scheme; or
- Where otherwise allowed by any applicable legislation.
